BUILDING & CODES DEPARTMENT:

 - He said the new Codes Enforcement software (Energov) will roll out July 17th. This will help the department and the contractors.

- Chief Crockarell stated that the general wage increase was great. He said they need to stay current with the pay to encourage employees not to look in seeking other agencies to work for.
- CPD currently has 21 vacancies right now.
- Councilperson Shakeehab asked a question about the signal light cameras. Chief Crockarell answered his question regarding the camera's. He said in the future there should be a discussion whether to keep the program going or not.
